We have opened two new programs for applications – Thriving Suburbs and Urban Precincts and Partnerships. Together, these programs deliver \$500 million of funding opportunities for communities in our capital cities and suburbs.



Thriving Suburbs is a funding program open to local government and notfor-profit organisations and provides funding between \$500,000 and \$15 million for community infrastructure – projects like libraries, playing fields and community centres.
